Registration has begun for Kindergarten 2017-2018. If you, or someone you know, have a child born in 2012, it is time to register them for Kindergarten.

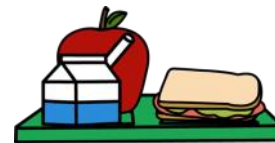
